- Am I on track to graduate?
- Do I have all the credits I need?

- Which AP courses fit my interests and strengths?
- What support is available if I struggle?
- Are there tutoring or academic support programs?
- What other academic opportunities should I know about?



4. PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

- Are my current classes preparing me for college?
- What should I consider when choosing next year's courses?
- Who else at school can help me with academic planning?
